



Leather Sizing Guide

INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF GETTING THE RIGHT FIT

The tables provided in each listing will provide you with a general guide to selecting the properly sized leather apparel. Each individual article of apparel may differ slightly than the measurements provided but they should be close enough to provide a good basis for size selection. After receiving your leather goods try on your item before removing any tags just in case you need to exchange it for a different size.

Each manufacturer uses a different sizing method and can be drastically different in size for the same letter size. So be sure and use the sizing chart in each listing and compare to your measurements before ordering. Some manufacturers have scrapped using the letter sizes and use the chest measurement as the size to avoid sizing mistakes. DO NOT just assume that you can order your common letter or chest size and have it fit correctly. Different styles of apparel are available in a different range of sizes. The sizes available for a particular listing are selected in the drop down above the price. Sometimes the larger sizes increase in cost. The patchwork leather brands like Diamond Plate tend to run larger than other brands letter size. For Diamond Plate jackets you need not add to your chest measurement while with other brands like All State Leather you should add 4" to your actual measurement. Be sure to read and follow the sizing directions and chart in each particular listing.
